# ***LISTEN SESSION REVEALED...And what we are going to do about it!***

After two months of meeting with groups at the church and in people's homes, your new Lead Pastor is ready to reveal 4 of the most consistently repeated hopes for High Street United Methodist Church. (I presented these at the October Church Council meeting.)

## **Revelation #1 – Better Communication**

*How are we going to better our communication?*

1. We are going to be more regular. Committees and Leadership Teams will meet more regularly, and information will be disseminated more regularly.
2. We are going to be more organized. The Staff-Parish Relations Committee is committed to creating an effective leadership organizational chart.
3. We are going to be more effective with our media. This will include a bulletin re-design, website update, creating a weekly email, and increasing our Facebook presence.

## **Revelation #2 – More Transparency**

*How are we going to be more transparent?*

We are going to remove the mystery surrounding 4 areas of church administration:

1. Money. Financial information will be published regularly in our worship bulletins and financial statements will be dispersed at Church Council meetings.
2. Trustees and the Building. Building Use and Maintenance Policies will be examined, updated, and communicated openly.
3. High Street Foundation. Education materials will be mass produced.
4. Leadership. A clear path to becoming a leader in the church will be publicized and all committee and ministry team members will have an understanding of their roles in the church.

## **Revelation #3 – More People**

Warning! More butts in seats does not equate to growing a church. I'm in the business of growing a church, not simply filling a church with warm bodies. So, if this congregation truly wants more people, then we are embarking on the journey of growing the church.

- Growing a church begins before someone reaches the door. What are the first things people see when they enter our parking lot and our building?
- Growing a church begins with our words. How are we talking about our church? What mission and vision of the church is being communicated?

**We are going to be a church that expects to grow.**

*How are we going to do this?*

1. Pray for God to grow the church the way God wants High Street UMC to grow.
2. Create a facility that is always welcoming of visitors and mindful of newcomers.
3. Fine tune and adequately communicate High Street UMC’s vision for fulfilling its mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.
4. Adequately follow-up with every newcomer to the church.
5. Provide multiple opportunities for all people associated with High Street UMC to connect with God and the community and to grow in their faith.

**Revelation #4 – “So, um, about the worship schedule...”**

By way of exploring our Sunday morning worship schedule, a Worship Commission will be formed. This Commission will consist of 6-10 people. The Commission will embark on a 6-9 month discernment process. The Commission will explore the current worship landscape of the Muncie community (research what is happening, when it’s happening and observe what is missing), whilst also explore High Street UMC’s needs, strengths, limitations, resources and desires. After the discernment process, a formal proposal will be submitted to a Church Conference for a church vote.

It was an honor to listen to each of you, to hear your stories, and to share your heart for High Street UMC and the Muncie community. I know I only arrived on July 1<sup>st</sup> and we are still in our “honeymoon period,” but I am honestly delighted to serve as your Lead Pastor and cannot wait to move ahead into our exciting future together! I am excited about the revelations listed above. It will be a lot of work, not just for me, but for all the leaders of the church. This is God’s church and each of us has been given the ultimate honor of serving the body of Christ in this particular place.

And all God’s people said: “Thanks be to God!”
