# Dear High Streeters:

“As members of this congregation, will you faithfully participate in its ministries by your prayers, your presence, your gifts, your service, and your witness?” When we respond “I will” to that question, we are received into the local congregation of The United Methodist Church.

Our Discipleship Process Team coming out of our Fruitful Congregation Consultation has formulated a table of what it might look like for a person to go deeper in his/her journey of faith with Christ. This table is built around our prayers, presence, gifts, service and witness. The goal is that we as a church will not simply be offering the next study or workshop based upon what sounds good at the time. The goal is that each of us will be actively examining in what area we need to move deeper in our faith, and that we as a church will intentionally offer opportunities for each of us to do so.

But where do we begin? Already we pastors are offering through our new member classes the opportunity to explore our prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness through the use of A Disciple's Path. We plan to offer the next class for prospective members in April and May.

This Lent Pastor Sherrie and I will be offering two more opportunities to move deeper. Pastor Sherrie will lead a group in A Disciple's Heart. This study emerges from the same authors of A Disciple's Path and again is built upon our Wesleyan tradition. Participants in A Disciple's Heart

will discover what John Wesley meant by a transformed heart as God's love “redirects our passions, restores our relationships with God and others, and reshapes our lives into the likeness of Christ.” A Disciple's Heart will be offered beginning Sunday, February 7 and go through Sunday, March 20.

I will be offering a study group on Tuesday evenings during Lent entitled “Followers Become Leaders.” This study will use material called Leadership from the Heart coming out of The United Methodist Church of the Resurrection pastored by Rev. Adam Hamilton. This group will begin meeting on February 16.

In addition, our Discipleship Process Team has offered a workshop on spiritual disciplines on Saturday, January 23, to help each of us explore how we may go deeper. We anticipate more workshops in the future to help us move deeper in our faith journey and relationship with Christ. Our Small Group Ministry Team is also moving forward to help offer more opportunities for growth, including the pancake and sausage supper on Sunday, January 31.

Your input along the way will be invaluable. Let the pastors know where you sense God wanting to move you in your journey and relationship with Christ. We want to partner with you and walk together as disciples of Christ.

## Letter from Sarah Dale

Karibu (welcome) Dear church family,

As part of my international affairs major at Indiana University, I am studying abroad at Ruaha Catholic University in Iringa, Tanzania from January 11 through May 2. My school has 2000 students. The area around the university is 1/3 Christian, 1/3 Muslim, and 1/3 tribal religions/other. 20% are HIV infected. I will be studying at the university for 3 months, and then I will spend one month with a host family doing field study on poverty and community development.

My passion for Tanzania has been developed over the years with the love and support of High Street Church. I was blessed to part of two High Street Church supported trips to Joy in the Harvest in Kigoma, Tanzania. The church was also very emotionally and financially supportive of my endeavor when I had the privilege to join a southern Indiana Methodist mission group that served at an orphanage in Ilula, Tanzania. These experiences have been a part of my journey and now I am studying in Tanzania. I want thank all of you for your encouragement, and I ask for continued prayer as I hope that this trip will be a life defining event that allows me to see where God is leading me in my vocational plan!

For those interested, I'd love to share my study in Tanzania experiences with you. I



have set up a blog that I hope to be able to maintain... that is as long as the glitchy Wi-Fi cooperates and my school responsibilities don't overwhelm me! You can follow me on SalamaMama on WordPress. Thank you for your love and prayers.
