# What's going on? A LOT!

Dear High Streeters:

I am sitting in my office at the church writing this on an early Tuesday afternoon. This morning we learned in staff that we had fifty from our church walking this last Saturday in the Muncie Mission's Walk-a-Mile. We raised a total of \$4,623 for the Muncie Mission. We did not win the Golden Sneaker this year; we came in third. But fifty of us walking and raising funds is still a number of which we can be proud.

During staff Kasey Needham, our Children's Ministries Director, had to excuse herself to meet with someone bringing an estimate for work on the ground floor. She has another similar meeting tomorrow, as we put figures together for revamping a floor on which to accommodate all of our children on a Sunday morning rather than have them spread to the two most distant floors. I anticipate we will be in a position to make presentations in the near future. I also know the FCJ Youth Ministry Team and the Youth Council have meetings this coming weekend for some proposed changes in the Youth Areas.

Casey Headland updated us in staff that she has been training Kasey Needham and Julie Buesink to fill her position while Casey is out on maternity leave in March. Casey and that little girl she is carrying are both doing well.

Denby Turner, our Building Superintendent, informed us that this week the handrails at the front of the sanctuary are to be installed.

Sandra Hardcastle reported her Grief Recovery Group has started. Bill and Sherrie Drake have begun their "A Disciple's Heart" short-term group. I start the "Followers Become Leaders"

tonight. And we have the "We're Not Martha Stewart" group starting later this month.

In pastoral staff, Pastor Sherrie and I chose a study to lead for Update Learning. That is in the planning for April and May. Did you know that when we count short-term small groups, which includes Update Learning, we had 74 of them last year? Pastor Sherrie and I also nailed down a time for me to meet with her, Kasey Needham, and Kristy Mahoney to discuss the Family Ministry Cohort in which we are participating to learn more about doing ministry with families.

People have been coming into our church during the middle of this day to receive assistance through our Samaritan Fund or food from our pantry. Each of these people has been invited to the parlor for a meal and conversation. Our pantry keeps a supply of Bibles handy because people visiting our pantry have requested Bibles. Do you recall seeing that last year we served 1,295 people through our pantry? We also helped 333 people through our Samaritan Fund with \$11,904.43. We have some wonderful servants here touching people in the name of Christ.

There's much more going on than what I have reported here. I haven't even reported some topics discussed today. There are plenty of ways in which people can worship, connect, and serve.

## Family Ministry – Are you IN?

Perhaps some of you noticed that the pastors have been praying for our Family Ministry Cohort team as part of the intercessory prayer in recent services. Others might have noticed that this team was a ministry focus on our church prayer list. You might wonder exactly what family ministry is. Who is this cohort team and what goals has it set?

The Indiana conference identified churches that had great potential to move into a healthy family ministry model, and invited these churches to join a year-long cohort to learn, grow, and plan together. High Street was invited to join this cohort shortly after the youth and children’s FCJ teams made recommendations to move in the direction of family ministry. The pastors and staff saw this as a great chance to take the momentum generated by the FCJ process and channel it into action. On February 6<sup>th</sup> a team of five High Streeters attended the first of several day-long seminars with this cohort. We look forward to monthly coaching from conference staff as well as three more all-cohort meetings in April, August, and October.

What, exactly, is family ministry? Family ministry looks to help the whole church family connect in intentional ways so that we might grow as disciples together. It aims to bridge gaps between groups in the church while simultaneously strengthening individual ministry areas. The word “family” can sometimes be confusing unless we remember that we are ALL family in the body of Christ- young, old, married, single, tall, short... everyone is part of our church family, and so family ministry is for all!

*Our family ministry cohort is aiming to help the full diversity of our church to **connect by worshipping, serving, learning, and discipling** together!*

We hope to do this by being:  
INtentional~

We “do faith” with purpose. (We find the “so that” for everything we do).

INtegrated~

We “do faith” within our daily lives.

INclusive~

We “do faith” with all people.

INtergenerational~

We “do faith” with all ages.

INcarnational~

We “do faith” with Christ at the heart of all we do.

We hope that the family ministry at High Street will help our church to be nourished, to grow, and to thrive so that our whole church community’s living faith will bear fruit across all generations.

So, how can you be IN? First, we invite the whole church family (and this means you!) to pray as we learn and plan. We invite you to pray about how you might come alongside others in the church family so that you might be able to “do faith” together.

We also have some specific opportunities coming up to worship, connect, and serve across generations and groups. New small groups are starting up now, and we will offer more just after Easter. Our young families Life Group continues to meet on Sundays at 11:00. The children’s Facilities Investigation Team and the youth FCJ team and youth council are making proposals to the trustees about how we can make our spaces more welcoming and functional. The missions team is working to communicate different missions opportunities monthly during all three worship services, and we look forward to offering opportunities for all generations to serve together in our community and abroad in the spring and summer. The youth are hoping to invite adults in the congregation to come alongside them as “Faith Partners” after Easter. Our All Church Activities Team is planning quarterly events that the entire church can enjoy- we look forward to an all-church “prom” on May 21<sup>st</sup> and the church picnic on August 28<sup>th</sup>. All of these are ways we can further invest in our church family.
